
communities better places to live. The Book of Golden Deeds Award exemplifies The National Exchange Club's beliefs.

Springfield Youth Symphony

Mark Sullivan presented a donation from the Exchange Club of Springfield Foundation in the amount of \$500 to Alex Peugh from the Springfield Youth Symphony.

Under the direction of Carlos Elias, this ensemble is comprised of our top student musicians from over 20 different schools and home schools in Clark, Champaign, Logan, Greene, Miami, Montgomery, and Shelby counties.

Since 1959, the SYS has provided one of the few opportunities in this area for young musicians to play in a full orchestral setting. Each season features several concerts and weekly rehearsals in the professional environment of the Kuss Auditorium at the Clark State Performing Arts Center.

The Youth Orchestra program has participated in exciting collaborations with the National Trail Parks and Recreation District, The Gary Geis Dance Company, The Springfield Museum of Art and the Clark State Community College Theater Program.

Exchange Club presented Award

The Exchange Club of Springfield, Ohio received the Springfield Police Division Citizen's Award for sponsoring the DARE program in the Springfield City Schools since 2010.

The D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) program is an internationally recognized, model program created in 1983 by the Los Angeles Police Department and the Los Angeles Unified School District.

D.A.R.E. provides students from kindergarten through high school with the skills necessary to recognize and resist pressures to experiment with drugs and to avoid gangs and violence. Lessons emphasize self-esteem, decision making, interpersonal communications skills, the consequences of drug abuse, conflict resolution and positive alternatives to substance abuse.

The most important facet of D.A.R.E. is the use of specially trained police officers to deliver the curriculum within the schools. Police Officers are accepted as authorities on drug abuse, as they deal with drug abuse and its consequences on a daily basis.
