Now, CAC provides the location where all of the disciplines involved meet under one roof which eliminates the need for children to be interviewed by multiple people.

Developed by the Exchange Club of Galesburg, Ill., the program is one of the Springfield club's signature projects. The DARE program students assist members in the distribution of the flags under the watchful eye of Exchangite and Police Officer Nate Ashcraft.
